CHECKLIST OF REQUIREMENTS FOR FLOOD CONVEYANCE CHANNEL ENCROACHMENT PERMIT APPLICATION

□ Completed application form; plus three complete sets of all documents provided.

□ A narrative of proposed work including, at a minimum:

- A general description of the proposed work effort.
- Area map with work site surveyed cross sections and established benchmarks delineated.
- Drawings of proposed work features within the flood control channel, including design details where appropriate.
- Detailed schedule of work including mobilization, construction and demobilization.
- Project design shall provide location of access to the Truckee River channel for construction equipment use. Carson Truckee Water Conservancy District shall have access necessary for repairs after encroachment.

Surveyed cross section and drawings prepared by a registered Nevada Professional Engineer (PE) or Professional Land Surveyor (PLS).

- Depict the channel upstream and downstream of proposed work area, and the immediate area of proposed work features.
- Extend cross sections to top of both banks of the flood control channel and show channel geometry below waterline, where possible.
- Tie survey into nearest, established benchmark (i.e. City of Reno, U.S.G.S., N.G.S.) related to NAD 1988.
- Show all measurements in survey feet, to the nearest 0.1 foot.
- Indicate date of survey and elevation of waterline.
- Provide copy of hydraulic modeling input/output as appropriate.
- Upon completion of construction provide AS-BUILT drawings of all improvements.

□ Pertinent permits or clearances (where applicable) issued from:
